## One God



*Deuteronomy 4:35.* "You were shown these things so that you might know that the Lord is God; **besides Him there is no other.**"

*Deuteronomy 6:4,5 - 4:* "Hear, O Israel: **the Lord our God, the Lord is one.**" *5:* "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength."

*Psalms 86:10.* "For you are great, and do marvelous deeds. **You alone are God.**"

*Isaiah 43:10b, 11.* *10b:* "**Before me no god was formed,** nor will there be one after me. *11:* "I, even I, am the Lord, and apart from me there is no savior."

*Isaiah 44:6.* "This is what the Lord says-- Israel's King and Redeemer, the Lord Almighty: I am the first and I am the last; **Apart from me there is no God.**"

*Isaiah 44:8.* "You are my witnesses. **Is there any God besides me?** I know not one."

*Isaiah 46:8,9.* *8:* "Remember this, fix it in mind, take it to heart you rebels. *9:* "Remember the former things, those of long ago, **I am God, and there is no other;** I am God, and there is none like me."

*I Cor. 8:4.* "We know that an idol is nothing at all in the world and that **there is no God but one.**"

*Eph. 4:4,5.* *4:* "There is one body and one Spirit--just as you were called to one hope when you were called--*5:* one Lord, one faith, one baptism; **one God and Father of all,** who is over all and through all and in all."

*Isaiah 9:6.* "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, **Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.**

*John 1:1-4.* 1: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God **and the Word was God.** 2: He was with God in the beginning. 3: Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. 4: In him was life, and that life was the light of men."

*John 5:18.* "For this reason the Jews tried all the harder to kill him; not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even **calling God his own Father making himself equal with God.**"

*Luke 22:70-23:1.* 70: "They all asked, '**Are you then the son of God?**' **He replied, 'You are right in saying I am.'** 71: Then they said, 'Why do we need any more testimony? We have heard it from his own lips.' 23:1 "Then the whole assembly rose and led him off to Pilate."

*John 20:2,29.* 28: "Thomas said to him, '**My Lord and my God!**' 29: Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you believe; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

*Romans 9:5.* "Theirs are the patriarchs, and from them is traced the human ancestry of Christ, **who is God over all**, forever praised! Amen." (There are variations of this verse.)

*Phil. 2:5,6.* 5: "Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: 6: **Who, being in very nature God**, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped."

*Col. 2:9.* "For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form."

*Titus 2:11-13.* 11: "For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. 12: It teaches us to say 'No' to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, 13: while we wait for the blessed hope--the glorious appearing of **our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ**,..."

*Hebrews 1:3.* "**The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being**, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After receiving purification for sins he sat down on the right hand of the Majesty in heaven."

*2 Peter 1:1.* "Simon Peter, a servant and apostle of Jesus Christ, to those who through the righteousness of **our God and Savior Jesus Christ** have received a faith as precious as ours..."

*1 John 5:20.* "We know also that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true. And we are in him who is true--even in his Son Jesus Christ. **He is the true God and eternal life.**"

## Jesus' Humanity



*John 1:14.* "The Word **became flesh and lived for a while among us**. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son who came from the Father, full of grace and truth."

*Luke 2:52.* "And Jesus **grew in wisdom and stature**, and in favor with God and man."

*Hebrews 2:8b-9.* 8: "In putting everything under him, God left nothing that was not subject to him. Yet at present we do not see everything subject to him. 9: But we see Jesus, **who was made a little lower than the angels**, now crowned with glory and honor because he suffered death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone."

*I John 4:2-3.* "This is how you can recognize the Spirit of God: Every spirit that acknowledges that **Jesus Christ has come in the flesh** is from God, but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world."

*I Cor. 8:6.* "Yet for us **there is but one God, the Father**, from whom all things came and for whom we live; **and there is but one Lord, Jesus Christ**, through whom all things came and through whom we live."

*Phil. 2:5-7.* 5: "Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: 6: Who, being in very nature God, **did not consider equality with God something to be grasped**, 7: but made himself nothing taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness."

*John 10:10.* "I and the Father are one."

*John 10:38.* "But if I do it, even though you do not believe me, believe the miracles that you may know and understand that **the Father is in me, and I in the Father.**"
